### Entry Requirements

Applicants must have a first-class or upper second-class undergraduate degree in a relevant subject. Applicants must not be in receipt of a full scholarship (tuition fees and living costs) from any other source; applicants in receipt of a partial scholarship from another source will be considered.

Please note that these scholarships are funded by an external sponsor. The successful applicants will be required to make their name and photograph available for use in MSc course publicity. The successful applicants will be required to prepare a short written report at the end of the course to highlight how the scholarship helped them in their studies.

### Apply Now

All applications for a place on one of the Masters degrees listed above that are received by **20 September 2013** (including those that have already been submitted) will be considered for these scholarships. There is no need to submit a separate application for these scholarships.

The scholarships will be awarded on the basis of academic merit as demonstrated by the application (qualifications,

personal statement, and references) – not financial need.

To apply, please use the links above and use the **Apply Now Online** option on the right-hand side of the course description. Applications must be received by 20 September 2013. Successful applicants will be notified as soon as possible after that date.

**IMPORTANT – In the Fees and Financial Support section of the application, you must state that you wish to be considered for the “September 2013 Engineering MSc Part-Fee Scholarships”.**

You should also indicate in this section if you completed your undergraduate degree at the University of Leicester and believe you may be eligible for the Alumni Discount Scheme.
