A full-time [postgraduate](#) scholarship is available for a suitably qualified candidate with a good honours [degree](#) in the [geography, geology, geochemistry](#) or related disciplines, to undertake [research](#) studies leading to a **PhD in Geosciences**. The project is to investigate the use of stable isotopes from authigenic carbonates in tropical volcanic crater-lakes for reconstructing change and variability in the Asian monsoon.

Eligibility:

Applicants should have a particular interest in geochemistry, palaeolimnology, and palaeoclimatology. Applicants must be Australian citizens, Australian permanent residents or [New Zealand](#) citizens.

Amount awarded:

The scholarship is valued at \$22,860 per annum (tax exempt) and may be renewed for up to three years, subject to satisfactory progress.
